ArtfulScribe is looking for Assistant Facilitators to support several writing and literature projects taking place across Dorset and the Solent area from September 2025.

Assistant Facilitators work alongside an experienced writer/facilitator to support the delivery of writing workshops with a wide range of participants. The role includes welcoming and helping participants to engage with the content of the workshops, assisting with administration and collecting evaluation data, and writing up a journal of the session. A list of projects coming up is available below; you will need to be able to travel to the relevant venue for workshops and be available for safeguarding training at Mayflower Studios, Southampton, on 6th September 2025.

Successful applicants will demonstrate a strong interest in supporting others, developing writing and facilitation skills and gaining experience working in an environment that supports diverse voices. You will need to be able to express yourself clearly and effectively through the written and spoken word. Previous experience is not essential but you need to be 18 or over.

This role is a freelance contract: you will be responsible for registering as self employed if required and paying your own tax and national insurance. An up to date DBS check will be required. This can be arranged, if necessary, through ArtfulScribe.

PROJECTS

Young and Junior Writers, Lighthouse Poole, Saturdays 9.15am – 2.45pm 13 Sept - 18 Oct & 8 Nov – 13 Dec (with potential to be ongoing).

Young and Junior Writers attend workshops led by professional writers, see Lighthouse performances, and have their work published or sometimes performed. The Assistant Facilitator will work with a lead Writer Facilitator to support three regular classes run on Saturday mornings on a weekly basis during term times for children and young people aged 7-10, 11-14 and 15-18. Workshops offer a safe, supportive environment, encouraging young writers to share work and to give and receive feedback in a respectful way that empowers voices in the workshop community.

Using the power of storytelling and words to connect people, Plot Lines aims to gather, listen to and share stories and anecdotes from people who live in and near Waterlooville. The Assistant

What Women Write will engage women from underrepresented communities through the lens of female fiction, looking at themes such as civic life, gender, women's roles and expectations, and cultural traditions, facilitated through workshops led by local writers. Responding to Jane Austen 250, women from across the city will be facilitated to express their stories and fictional writing through multi-lingual visual and/or audible media. Working with a lead writer, Assistant Facilitators will support two or more workshops and be part of a final project sharing.
